

ATM SECURITY

ATMs are one of the most convenient ways to bank. But, to criminals, they are just another way to try and steal your personal information. Follow the steps below to protect your personal information from falling into the wrong hands.



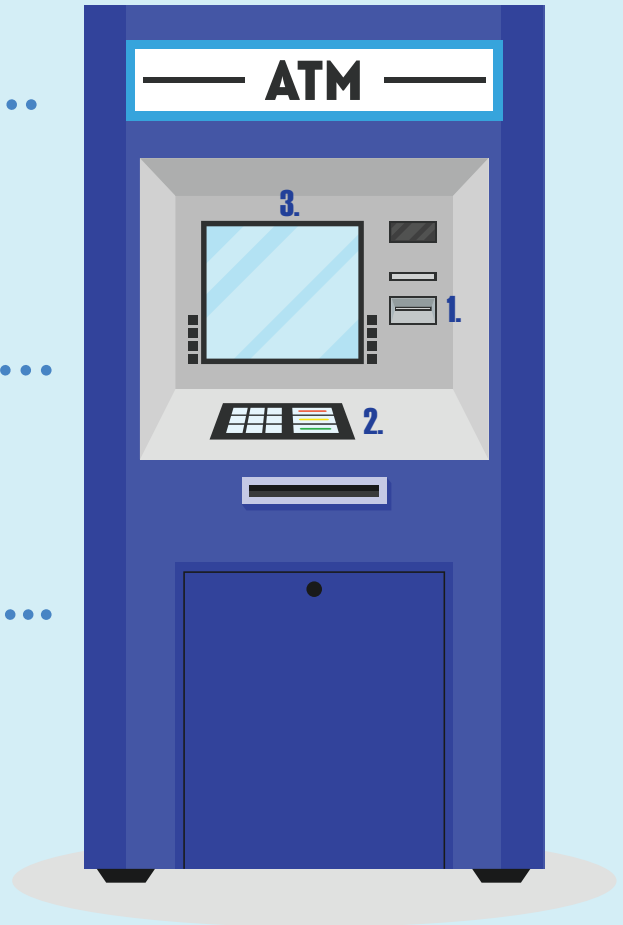
Card Slot – Before inserting your card, grab and pull the card reader to see if a skimming device has been mounted.



PIN Pad – Feel the PIN pad for a false pad or overlay before entering your PIN.



Pinhole Camera – If there is a skimming device on the ATM, a pinhole camera will be placed somewhere above the PIN pad. Make sure to always use your free hand to cover the numbers when entering your PIN.



Always be aware of your surroundings and be sure to report anything out of the ordinary. No part of an ATM should ever be loose or have added parts that can easily be removed.
